Non-Competition Policy

Scope

The policy applies to all residency and fellowship programs at CCHS.

Purpose

The Sponsoring Institution must maintain a policy which states that neither the Sponsoring Institution nor any of its ACGME-accredited programs will require a resident/fellow to sign a non-competition guarantee or restrictive covenant.

Policy and Guidelines

It is the policy that neither the College of Community Health Sciences nor any of its residency and fellowship programs will require residents or fellows to sign a non-competition guarantee (restrictive covenant).

The Graduate Medical Education Committee is charged with monitoring the programs of CCHS to ensure compliance with this policy.
